Wisconsin Fund Update



For WOWRA members that have been assisting a Wisconsin homeowner who applied and is eligible for Wisconsin Fund proceeds in 2015, please be aware of the recent update from the DSPS as it relates to the amount and timing of POWTS Fund awards.

Per the October 26 DSPS update:

- Grant award disbursements for the current period began the week of October 19-23 and were scheduled to be complete by the end of October.
- As in previous years, grant applications exceeded available funds.
- Wisconsin homeowners that experienced category 1 failures are scheduled to receive approximately 80% of what they were eligible for.
- No category 2 failures were awarded.
- Checks should be received by participating units of local government in early November

WOWRA (and its members) prides itself on being a strong partner with the homeowners and communities in which we are honored to serve. With that said, please feel free to pass this important information along to customers that you know were eligible for the Wisconsin Fund or those who may be interested.

Fall Legislative Floor Period Concludes November 5

During the last couple months, the state legislature has been primarily focused on legislation affecting government and government reform. You may have been reading, hearing or watching coverage of your elected officials passing legislation to limit John Doe investigations, reforming the make-up and operation of the Government Accountability Board, as well as updating and modifying Wisconsin's campaign finance laws.

While some of that may directly or indirectly affect you and your business, the Assembly and Senate has passed two pieces of legislation that may affect you as employers or your employee drivers. Those two pieces of legislation are:

- AB 208/SB 157 Restriction Cards/Operators Licenses This bill eliminates the requirement for the DOT to issue special restrictions cards in addition to an operators CDL
- AB 209/SB 158 CDL's This bill makes a number of miscellaneous changes to the statutes related to CMVs. The DOT was compelled to make these changes to codify Wisconsin state statutes with federal regulations. Most importantly, this bill continues to allow the use of cellular telephones for a driver of a CMV, it ensures they are only permitted in certain situations. Those situations are:
 - ♦ Can still use phone if using the "hands-free" option
 - ♦ Can still use phone if answering or calling by pressing a single button
 - ♦ Can still use phone if they maintain a seated position to reach / use phone

General Plumbing Classroom Courses

Health Care, Course # 17268

Fee \$30

Three hours of credit for MP, MPRA, JP, JPRA, UDC PI and Comm PI. CCC Device Tester

This continuing education course will cover healthcare issues. Designation of facilities will be discussed. This course will focus on conformance to provisions of SPS 382.50. Issues of maintenance of hot water and options for bacterial control. Pure water systems will also be discussed.

MPP, Course # 17266

Fee \$30

Three hours credit for MP, MPRA, JP, JPRA, UDC PI and Comm PI

This three hour training focuses on the design and installation of a multipurpose piping system (MPP) that incorporates a domestic water supply system that supplies water to plumbing fixtures and individual fire sprinklers located within dwelling units. It is a water distribution system set up with fire sprinklers in accordance with NFPA 13D Standard. The class is mandatory for plumbers who received their licenses prior to January 1, 2002 per SPS 305.91(6)(b), to install MPP systems. The class provides a MPP Manual and CD calculators.

Storm, Course # 17270

Fee \$30

Three hours of credit for MP, JP, MPRS, JPRS, UC, UDC PI and Comm PI, Soil Tester Certification

This continuing education course will cover storm system design and submittals to the department. The different types of storm systems including pretreatment, detention, and infiltration design.

Plumbing Topics, Course # 17269

Fee \$30

Three hours of credit for MP, JP, UDC PI and Comm PI, CCC Device Tester

This continuing education course will cover an array of topics throughout Chapter SPS 382. This course will be geared mainly at code questions, asked by you, that have been addressed by the department over the past year or so, along with the Department's responses.

POWTS Classroom Courses

Plan Design and Submittal Course # 16792 Fee \$30

Three hours of credit for MP, MPRS, JP, JPRS, POWTS Maintainer, CST, POWTS Insp and Comm PI

This course will lead participants through the step by step process for designing common component manual systems. Also covered is an introduction to using the new standard plan pages and what is needed for a complete state plan submittal.

Special Reports, Course # 16793

Fee \$30

Three hours of credit for MP, MPRS, JP, JPRS, POWTS Maintainer, CST, POWTS Insp and Comm PI

Not every site's features are easily identified and applied to the code. This course explores the group of special procedures outlined in SPS 385.60 which help the CST explain water movement and other soil characteristics as they pertain to POWTS.

POWTS Potpourri, Course # TBD

Fee \$30

Three hours of credit for MP, JP, MPRS, JPRS, POWTS Inspector, POWTS Maintainer, and Comm Pl.

Various short subjects on many different aspects of POWTS design, installation, operational theory and code interpretation will be covered. Topics discussions include but not limited to expectations at POWTS installation and inspection, when permits are required, addressing filled and compacted sites, State owned property permitting process, POWTS math, plan submittal and more. Bring additional questions and thoughts to share.

Hands on Soil, Course # TBD

Fee \$30

Three hours of credit for MP, JP, MPRS, JPRS, POWTS Inspector, and Comm Pl.

This "hands on" educational opportunity will cover the basics of writing and reading profile descriptions, texturing soil samples from across the state and discussion of soil and site photographs. Attention will be given to determining sand sizing and identifying "good" mound sand, clay content, coarse fragment content, fill soils and wet sites along with relationships to POWTS sizing and design. Course will also address importance and practice of drawing appropriate plot plans and methodology of establishing surface contours. Be sure to bring your Munsell color book, engineer scale, calculator and pencil.


